- (c) The Imphal East District Administration of Manipur state Government has launched a new initiative "Food Bank" based on the theme 'Help End Hunger Today' with the aim to provide free food to the poor people who are severely affected in getting essential commodities due to the long statewide lockdown in view of the threat of Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- (a) Lebanon became the 1st Arab nation to legalise cannabis (also known as marijuana) farming for medicinal & industrial use with the aim to boost the exports & to beat the economic crisis created by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Lebanon faces the worst economic crisis due to lockdown since the 1975-1990 civil wars.

- 42 (a) Union Minister for Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) Nitin Gadkari announced an Agro MSME Policy that will focus on entrepreneurship development in rural, tribal, agricultural, and forest areas for manufacturing products using local raw material. The Agro MSME policy is launched to focus and uplift the MSME sector which is affected during lockdown amidst COVID-19.
- 43. (d) The Himachal Pradesh government has decided to launch an employment guarantee scheme called "MukhyaMantri Mantri Shahari Rozgar Guarantee Yojna" with an aim to improve the economy of the state affected by the Coronavirus. The Yojna will provide 120 days of employment to those living in urban areas.
- **44.** (b) Ayush Kavach mobile app has been launched by the state government of Uttar Pradesh. The app provides health-related tips and information about Ayurveda medicine on novel coronavirus infection.



- 45. (b) NITI Aayog in partnership with Piramal Foundation launched the 'Surakshit Dada-Dadi & Nana-Nani Abhiyan' campaign to ensure the well-being of senior citizens during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 46. (d) As per the Global Report on Internal Displacement (GRID) 2020 report, 5 million people were displaced in India in 2019, which is the highest in the world, due to disasters, including cyclones and monsoon floods.
- 47. (c) An Aid agency of United States-The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) has announced to provide an additional \$3 million to India, for mitigating the spread of COVID-19. The fund will be utilized under Partnerships for Affordable Healthcare Access and Longevity (PAHAL) project.
- **48.** (d) Prime Minister Narendra Modi participated in a virtual summit of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM). The aim behind this summit was to enhance the coordination of the member states in their fight against the COVID-19 pandemic. The summit was conducted under the Presidency of Azerbaijan.
- **49.** (a) Russia will be launching its first satellite to monitor the Arctic climate and environment l this year. Arktika-M remotesensing and emergency communications satellites will gather meteorological data in the polar regions of the Earth, which will allow improving weather forecasts and will enable scientists to better study climate change.
- 50. (a) Indian Navy launched Operation Samudra Setu to bring back the Indian citizens who are stranded overseas because of the COVID-19 pandemic. This operation is done by the Ministries of Defence, External Affairs, Home Affairs, Health, and various other agencies of Central/State government,
- 51. (c) Delhi retains the top spot in terms of Internet penetration as per 'Digital in India' report released recently by Nielsen and IAMA.
- 52. (a) An agreement between the Government of India and the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) has been signed for the approval of a loan of \$500 million

for the "COVID-19 Emergency Response and Health Systems Preparedness Project". The loan amount will help India to combat the COVID-19 pandemic situation and strengthen its public health.

- 53. (d) Uttar Pradesh government has launched 'Pravasi Rahat Mitra' App for migrant workers of state who are returning from different parts of the country amidst lockdown. The state revenue department in collaboration with the United Nation Development Program (UNDP) has developed this app.
- 54. (b) The government of India launched "Mission Sagar" to provide assistance to Eastern Indian Ocean Region Nations in the COVID-19 pandemic situation. The mission is inspired by PM Modi's vision of SAGAR (Security and Growth for All in the Region).
- 55. (d) Registrar General of India has released Birth rate, Death rate, and IMR data. The data states that India's infant mortality rate (IMR) has improved very marginally from 33 per 1,000 live births in 2017 to 32 in 2018. Kerala has received the best IMR value in single digits at 7.
- 56. (d) CSIR-National Aerospace Laboratories (NAL) Bangalore has developed a Non-Invasive Bilevel Positive Airway Pressure (BiPAP) Ventilator named as 'SwasthVayu'. This ventilator has been developed in a record time of 36 days to treat COVID-19 patients.
- 57. (d) Five startup firms have been honoured with the Startup India Animal Husbandry Grand Challenge Award namely, White Gold Technologies LLP, Mumbai; Krushak Mitra Agro Services Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai; MoooFarm, Gurugram, Haryana; EmerTech Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai; and Adis Technologies, Belagavi, Karnataka.
- 58. (c) The Department of Consumer Affairs has launched the 'Suraksha Stores initiative to use technology to prevent the spread of Covid-19 at the local Kirana store level with the help of two tech startups Safejobs and Seekify.
- **59.** (a) FIR Aapke Dwar Yojana has been launched by the state government of Madhya Pradesh. Under this Yojana, a person would not be required to visit the police station to lodge an FIR.

- 61. (a) Associated Chambers of Commerce and Industry of India (ASSOCHAM) organized a virtual conference between India and Bangladesh. The conference was addressed by Union Development of North Eastern Region(DoNER) Minister Jitendra Singh and focussed on the vital role of the North Eastern region in order to boost the trade between the two countries.
- 62. (b) Union Minister of Health & Family Welfare Dr. Harsh Vardhan participated in the 32nd Commonwealth Health Ministers' Meeting which was conducted through video conference. The theme of the conference was "Delivering a co-ordinated Commonwealth COVID-19 response."
- 63. (c) The World Economic Forum (WEF) has released the Energy Transition Index (ETI) 2020. This time, India has ranked 74th position on the global Energy Transition Index (ETI). In the previous year, it was ranked at 76th position.
- 64. (d) The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy launched an initiative called 'One Sun One World One Grid'. This initiative is launched to interconnect renewable energy by sharing solar resources with more than 140 countries of West Asia and Southeast Asia.
- 65. (d) Sports Authority of India (SAI) in collaboration with National Sports Federations (NSF) has launched India's first ever sports e-pathshala named as Khelo India e-Pathshala. It is a national level open online coaching and education programme on sports.
- 66. (c) NASSCOM has delivered an end-toend coronavirus tracking platform for Karnataka which is named as Karnataka Listening Dashboard for COVID-19. It is an analytics driven platform which will assist Karnataka state in recovering the industrial economy and help them to recover after the reopening stage of the state.
- 67. (c) Union Electronics and IT Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad launched a National program for youth in India called 'Responsible AI for Youth'. The national program will provide a platform to India' youth and will empower them to inculcate AI-based skills and learn AI tools in order

to make them digitally strong and ready for the Digital future of the nation.

From the report, India is ranked at 23rd position for 2020. The ranking is topped by the United States followed by the United Kingdom.
- 74. (c) The South African National Space Agency (SANSA) has collaborated with National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) to support human space flight



missions to the Moon, Mars and beyond. Now South Africa has thus become the 4th country to host a deep-space ground station after the US, Spain and Australia.

- **75.** (c) India signs MoU with Bhutan to improve the cooperation in the areas of Environment. The MoU will promote a long term cooperation between India and Bhutan to protect the environment and manage natural resources.
- 76. (d) Virtual Global Vaccine Summit 2020 was conducted on 4th June 2020 and was hosted by the United Kingdom. United Kingdom's Prime Minister Boris Johnson led the Global Vaccine Summit 2020.
- 77. (a) Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL) has partnered with MAITREE Program (Market Integration and Transformation Program for Energy Efficiency) to launch the Energy Efficient Buildings Initiative. MAITREE Program is launched by USAID (US Agency for International Development).
- 78. (c) The Indian Space Research Organisation has signed a MoU agreement with ARIES (Aryabhatta Research Institute of Observational Science) for the cooperation in the field of Space Situational Awareness (SSA) and Astrophysic.
- **79.** (a) The Indian Air Force has designed and inducted Airborne Rescue Pod for Isolated Transportation (ARPIT) for the purpose of evacuation of critical patients suffering from COVID-19 from high altitude, isolated areas.
- 80. (c) The Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) has launched a flagship programme called 'Turant Customs'. 'Turant Customs' is a reformative programme in order to ensure ease of doing business.
- (b) An annual allotment of Rs 4000 crore has been approved by Government of India to State governments under 'Per drop more crop' component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY-PDMC) for FY 2020-21.
- 82. (d) Deep Submergence Rescue Vehicle (DSRV) was inaugurated at Eastern Naval Command (ENC) in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh. The complex is built to

accommodate newly designed submarines and its rescue systems and store DSRV assets.

- 83. (c) Union Agricultural and Farmers Welfare Minister Narendra Singh Tomar launched Sahakar Mitra – a Scheme on Internship Programme (SIP) of NCDC (National Cooperative Development Corporation). This scheme will provide practical experience of the co-operative and professional world to the youth of India.
- 84. (c) Joint Science Communication Forum is constituted by DST (Department of Science and Technology). It is constituted to facilitate interaction, co-operation and co-ordination among various public sector science communication institutions and agencies.
- 85. (c) National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) has become the first fully digitalized organisation under the construction sector category. NHAI has propelled the use of cloud-based technology and AI-powered big data analytics platform, which is powered by Data Lake and project management services.
- 86. (d) The Government of India has launched an Arogya Path which is a web-based solution which provides availability of critical healthcare supply commodities on a real-time basis. The web-based solution is made available by the government of India on CSIR National Healthcare Supply Chain Portal.
- 87. (c) India has signed a MoU with Denmark in the field of Energy Co-operation in order to develop the power sector. The two countries will boost their power sector on the basis of equality, reciprocity and mutual benefit.
- 88. (a) India has been ranked at 168th position among 180 countries with a score of 27.6 out of 100 in Environment Performance Index 2020. The list has been topped by Denmark with a score of 82.5.

- 90. (d) The IT giant Tech Mahindra has signed a declaration of United Nations Global

- **91.** (c) The World Bank has released its latest edition of Global Economic Prospects (GEP) for the months of June 2020. The Global Economic Prospects describes analytical growth of various countries by considering various parameters. As per the report, India's growth is to contract by 3.2% for the financial year 2020-21.
- **92.** (d) World Bank has granted financial support by providing a loan amount of Rs 1950 crore to West Bengal. The loan amount will help West Bengal to tackle the pandemic situation of COVID-19 and to carry out development work in the state.
- 93. (d) Quacquarelli Symonds (QC) World University Ranking for 2021 is released. The ranking is topped by Massachusetts Institute for Technology (MIT) followed by Stanford University and Harvard University. Only 3 Indian Institutes are included in the top 200 ranking category which are IIT Bombay, Indian Institute of Science Bangalore and IIT Delhi.
- 94. (d) The Nature Index 2020 highlights the ranking of the academic institutions globally. The currently released Nature Index 2020 report analyses the institutions in terms of high quality research in the natural science field based on the research data published by them in top journals from 1st Jan 2019 to 31st Dec 2019. As per the report, the top three institutions are Chinese Academy of Sciences holding 1st rank, followed by Harvard University of USA and Max Planck Society, Germany.
- **95.** (c) A state of the art flood warning system called 'I-FLOWS' has been launched in Mumbai, Maharashtra. 'I-FLOWS' is a state of the art Integrated Flood Warning System.

- 106. (a) Cyclone Amphan made landfall in West Bengal, India, near the Bangladeshi border. Amphan became the strongest storm ever recorded in the Bay of Bengal. It is the first tropical cyclone of the 2020 North Indian Ocean cyclone season, Amphan's origins can be traced back to a low-pressure area situated over the Bay of Bengal on April 29.
