National Sports Award 2020

On 29th August 2020, The President of India awarded the National Sports Awards to the athletes in a virtual ceremony. The award was announced on 21st August, 2020, by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. The awards were recommended by the Selection Committee headed by Justice (Retd.) Mukundakam Sharma (former Judge of Supreme Court of India). The event took place at the Rashtrapati Bhavan but the prevailing situation in the country saw sportspersons receiving their awards in a virtual ceremony. This award is given to the sports person in 7 categories. A total of 74 sportspersons were rewarded by the President. The winners of the Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award, Arjuna Award, Dronacharya Award, Dhyan Chand Award, Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award and Rashtriya Khel Protsahan Puraskar were also awarded by the President. This is the first time that the National Sports Day is being held online, instead of the traditional Rashtrapati Bhavan do, on August 29. India celebrates the birthday of hockey legend Dhyan Chand as National Sports Day every year. Nine award winners, including three who have tested positive for COVID-19, will not attend the ceremony.

Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award

The award is presented to sportspersons with most outstanding performance in the field of sports for a period of four years. It is the country's highest sporting honour. This year this award has been given to five sports persons.
