Granting more powers to **Delhi LG**





STRENGTHS

- Will put an end to the growing tussle between Delhi Government and the LG over supremacy.
- Will end the speculation on the lack of clarity on what proposal need to be sent to LG for his approval and thus will also stop ambiguities.



WEAKNESSES

- Will cause problems related to various administrative decisions and will hinder execution of day to day businesses.
- There will also be increased friction between the Centre, the legislature and the executive.
- Delhi Government will now have to seek the opinion of the L-G before any executive decision and it will undermine the validity of the elected CM.



OPPORTUNITIES

- Due to lack of clarity on this issue there were various important schemes which remained in the files for years and can be implemented now.
- Will facilitate now more public centric policies without unreasonable delay.
- Will bring balance in exercise of powers through constitutional provisions which led to effective governance of the people.



THREATS

- By granting supremacy of LG, the legislative assembly and the elected representatives seems meaningless and have dangerous consequences for the country's federal structure.
- Parliament's power to override the legislative authority of the states in normal circumstances is not a good precedence.
